Social Workers in Schools (SWiS) is a community social work service delivered in primary, intermediate and composite schools and Kura Kaupapa Māori.

Schools are provided with a Social Worker based on the needs in the school community. Social Workers work with children. their families/whānau and schools to help protect vulnerable children and develop plans to improve their safety, wellbeing and educational outcomes. Services provided by the social workers include individual case work. as well as group-based programmes for children and parents.



Felt safe and know where to go for help




Feel that their basic needs are met


